### Part I: Agile Project Management

In this two-hour webinar, a Rally coach will walk your team through the process of planning and scheduling software projects, releases and iterations using story cards. We will then demonstrate how to run an agile iteration by managing a story card's state and sub-tasks, while communicating progress to the entire organization.

### Part II: Customer-Centric Requirements Management

This one-hour webinar introduces your team to customer-centric requirements management using Rally. We will suggest some effective and intuitive feature breakdown structures and present simple ways to place these structures into your backlog of story cards. We will then discuss the agile concepts of just-in-time elaboration along with two-tiered estimating techniques that support optimal planning practices.

### Part III: Agile Testing and Defect Management

This one-hour webinar describes how to use Rally for agile testing and defect management. We will demonstrate how Rally improves visibility into a feature's status by associating test cases and defects to requirements. We will then discuss how your team can use these associations to pull testing forward in the development cycle.
