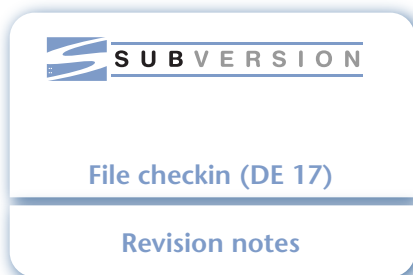

- Increases the utility of your source control management system by giving it added project management capability

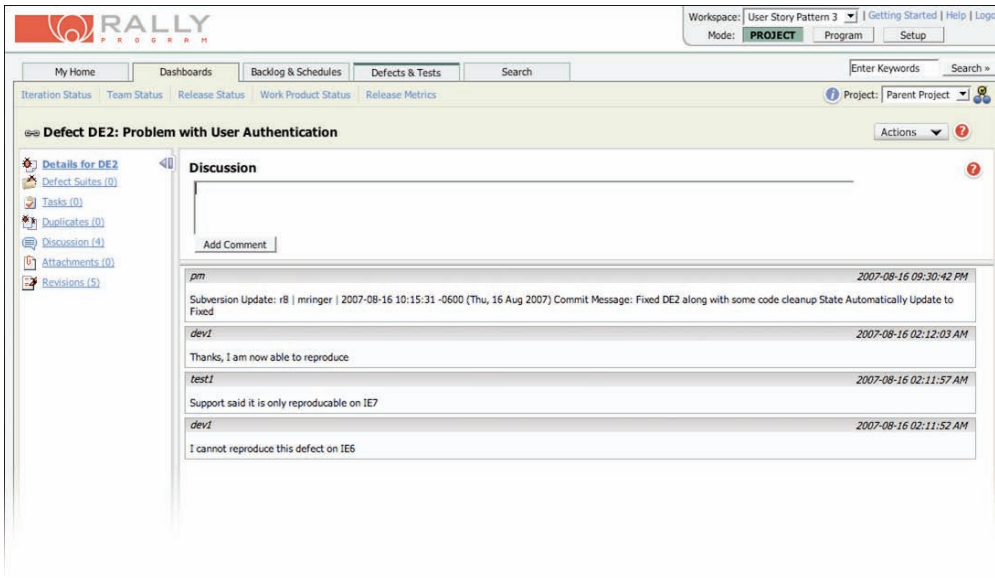


Usage Scenario

1. The developer commits code to the Subversion repository in order to fix an open defect.
2. In the revision notes, the developer includes the Rally formatted ID (example DE17) associated to that defect with notes for the tester and the status of 'fixed'.
3. The Rally Connector reads the code check-in in Subversion and updates the status of DE17 to 'fixed' in Rally and attaches the revision notes to the defect's discussion.
